- +Though the LORD is great, he cares for the humble, but he keeps his distance from the proud. (138.6)
- +The LORD supports the humble, but he brings the wicked down into the dust. (147.6)
- +For the LORD delights in his people; he crowns the humble with salvation. (149.4)
- +The LORD mocks at mockers, but he shows favor to the humble. (3.34)
